

Office of Early Childhood SY 19-20 Guidance for Families on Spring Collection Report Cards


- 1. Teachers will share your child's Report Card through MyTeachingStrategies
- 2. You will receive an email from Teaching Strategies with subject [Child's name]- "Report Card" [time sent]. ex: Jennifer "Report Card" 10:29 AM
- 3. The body of the email will contain the message below



- 4. Select continue
- 5. The link will bring you to the login screen



6. If you already created an account login. If not, select Sign Up and follow the directions.


